


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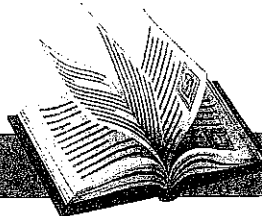
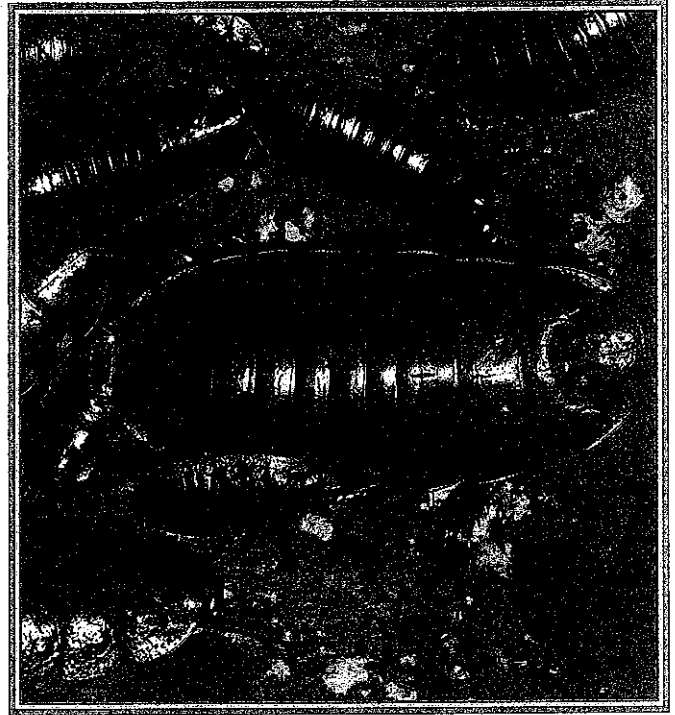
## Why can cockroaches live almost anywhere?

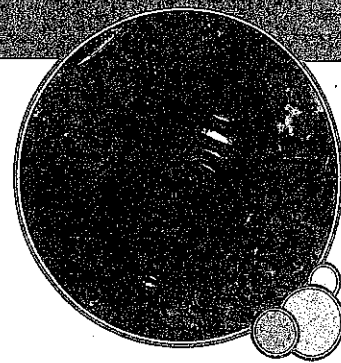
2 There are more than 4,000 kinds of cockroaches in the world. Some live in forests. Some live in deserts. Others live in caves. Many cockroaches live in big cities.
